

End of Lease Flea Pre-Treatment Checklist

Description of Treatment

An End of Lease Flea treatment consists of our technicians treating all harbourage areas deemed necessary and safe by our technician these may include:

- Carpeted areas internally
- Rood void and subfloor
- Outside entertainment areas, lawns & gardens.
- Shedding and Garages

Thank you for choosing Gippsland Pest Management for your End of Lease Flea Treatment, prior to our arrival please ensure the following has been carried out:



1. The home is completely vacant with no personal possessions/ furniture in the home
2. Your home has had carpet steam cleaning and the full vacate clean completed before our technicians attend the property
3. All lawn areas need to be well maintained and low to allow the chemical to penetrate the soil below
4. Ensure all windows and doors are closed prior to and during treatment and until the chemical has dried. Approx. 1-2 hours.
5. That arrangements have been made to vacate the premises after our technicians arrival for a minimum of 4 hours
6. That our technicians are aware of any ponds or pet fish at the property.
7. All shedding and garage areas that you would like treated are unlocked and access is available for our technician.

Control Period & After Care Program

This treatment includes a **3 month After Care Program**. This means the real estate are covered for our technicians to reattend your property within this timeframe for any issues. After your initial treatment, it can take up to **30 days** to gain full control of the population onsite

Payment Options

Payment for this treatment is required on the day of treatment, Gippsland Pest Management can accept payment via Cash, EFT & Cheque.
