Possum Management Pre-Treatment Checklist



Description of Program

Possums are a protected species so in all cases the best method is to exclude the possum/s from your building

The process for this would usually involve monitoring the roof space or area where we think they are gaining entry and then using either a one-way door or possum cage to trap or exclude them from the building and then proof this area so they can't gain entry again. We would then continue to monitor the area for several days as in some cases there are multiple possums living in the building

- **1.** Our onsite monitoring camera requires internet access. Please let us know if you do not have internet at your site so we can make other arrangements
- **2.** DO NOT block any holes or openings before the technician has attended site as you may trap the possum/s inside the building. Just let the technician know the location/s when he arrives onsite
- **3.** DO NOT try to catch the possum yourself as they can get very aggressive and only a trained professional should handle them in a safe and humane way
- **4.** If a possum has been caught in a cage, DO NOT touch the cage or disturb the possum in any way as you could accidentally release the possum. Possums can also die from stress so please leave it alone if caught
